In support of school safety, Ohioans can report school safety concerns through a new smartphone app, available on iOS and Android devices and an <u>online web</u> <u>form</u> which includes pre-populated prompts to help users quickly upload information to the state's free <u>Safer Ohio School Tip Line</u> (1-844-SAFEROH). October 2023 marks the second annual Ohio School Safety Month. This year's theme is "Relationships for Safety," which recognizes the impact that positive relationships between school staff and students play in maintaining a safe learning environment. October is also Learning Disabilities and Dyslexia Awareness Month

Learning disabilities represent a range of neurologically-based processing challenges that may affect skills such as reading,

writing, and arithmetic. Importantly, these disabilities do not measure one's intelligence or capability. Instead, they illustrate a difference in information processing by the brain. Examples include Dyslexia, ADHD, Dyscalculia, and Dyspraxia. Each disability is distinct, but what remains consistent is the potential for success with the right support. There is no cure for learning disabilities and individuals with this condition must learn coping strategies. The <u>Learning</u> <u>Disabilities Association of America</u> as well as the <u>International Dyslexia Association (IDA)</u> are full of resources for parents, educators, adults, professionals and students.
